

# Receive your interlibrary loan articles by email

*A faster method of delivery for interlibrary loan articles*

You can request articles to be emailed directly to you in secure PDF format. Just follow the steps below.

## Step 1: Test that you can receive secure PDF documents.

Download a test document from the British Library website: <http://www.bl.uk/sed>

If you do not have Adobe Digital Editions installed on your PC, the Adobe Digital Editions detector will ask you to install it. Installing is free and only takes a minute.

**Check there is no pop-up blocker in action to hinder the download**

**Note:**

- SGUL Staff can contact [ITAV@sgul.ac.uk](mailto:ITAV@sgul.ac.uk) to get help with installing Adobe Digital Editions on their work computer.
- NHS staff and SGUL students are advised to install the software on their home computer.

Once the software is installed **and** you've been able to receive the test document, you will be able to request articles by email.

## Step 2: Request to receive articles by email

Tick the box provided for receiving articles by email on the online or paper request form.

## Step 3: Download article from your email inbox

Your article will arrive from this British Library email address: **noreply@bldss.bl.uk**

Download the document within 30 **days** of receipt; after this period the document will automatically be deleted.

**The document can only be printed once.** Once downloaded, most documents can be stored in Adobe Digital Editions for up to 3 years, but it is recommended that the article is deleted once printed.
