

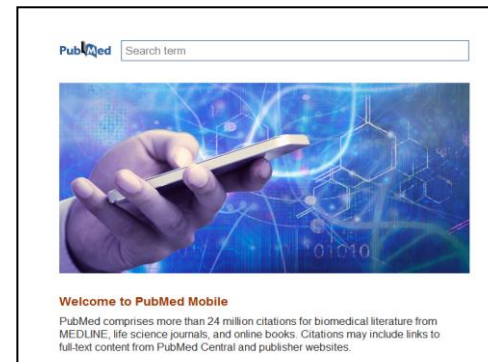
## PubMed on your mobile

PubMed is a free online interface from the US National Library of Medicine that allows you to search the Medline database. Where possible, it also provides access to freely available full text articles.

### PubMed on your mobile

You can also search PubMed on the go via your mobile device. There are a number of ways of doing this.



1. You can visit National Library of Medicine's (NLM) "PubMed Mobile" webpage

2. 'PubMed for Handhelds', from the NLM, allows you to use the clinical queries function to search specifically for primary evidence in addition to the main database.
